Ola Gjeilo was born in Norway in 1978 and moved to the United States in 2001 to begin his composition studies at the Juilliard School in New York City, where he currently resides and works as a full-time composer.

Ola's recordings include the Decca Classics albums *Ola Gjeilo* and *Winter Songs*, featuring Tenebrae, Voces8 and the Choir of Royal Holloway. Ola was also composer-in-residence for the Phoenix Chorale in 2009-2010.

Today's concert features two pieces by Ola, *Ubi Caritas* and *Lux*. This will be the North American premiere of *Lux*, first performed last November by the Fairhaven Singers in Cambridge, England.

The piece is especially poignant for our Director, Eleanor Johnson, and her husband, Graham. The work was commissioned by their son, Matthew, and his wife, Libbi, and dedicated in loving memory of their stillborn son, Benedict. Benedict is survived by his twin sister, Imogen (only 13 ounces at birth) who is now 8 months old and doing amazingly well.
