KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

- Performers should wear their groups colors or choir shirts and comfortable pants, shorts or skirts.
- Chase Field is a Cashless Ballpark. https://www.mlb.com/dbacks/ballpark/information/guide
- Pre-Purchase Parking: https://www.mlb.com/dbacks/ballpark/transportation/parking
- Chase Field Clear Bag & Bottle Policy: www.dbacks.com/bagpolicy Traditional purses, bags and backpacks are not allowed in the stadium, only clear bags. Empty water bottles or water in clear sealed bottles permitted.
- Food, drinks, bags and purses will not be allowed onto the field. Please leave all bags and purses with guests
- No talking during the rehearsal and on the field prior to the performance
- Anyone on field will show proper respect before, during and after the National Anthem performance.
- Stand up straight and DO NOT WAVE at the cameras.
- Stay on the warning track and off the grass at all times during the performance.
- All must have a ticket to enter stadium (except for babes in arms) use this link for discount tickets in NVC sections https://fevo-enterprise.com/event/nvc23

PERFORMANCE TIMELINE:

3:00pm: Gates to Chase Field Open at this time.

CALL TIME - 3:15PM:

All anthem singers should be at Chase Field at this time. Please enter the ballpark through any one of the Chase Field entry gates to get tickets scanned and bags checked. All performers must do this before going to the rehearsal area, so please give yourself plenty of time to do so.

3:30PM: All anthem singers should proceed to the rehearsal area located outside Gate J on the east side of the ballpark (near sections 110-111), under the 7th street bridge. Get into SATB zone based on tyour part. As long as you remain in the SATB corral, you are considered "in the ballpark" and do not need to scan back in/out. Performers and Group Leaders ONLY- all guests go inside to their seats. (NOTE - Group Leaders, please begin lining up participants in a semi-circle for the rehearsal. Each zone should be arranged in rows of 4, riser-style, shortest in front and tallest in back.

3:50PM: All Group Leaders should meet at the front of the rehearsal area to go over basic performance details.

3:55PM: Pre-game rehearsal led by Joshua Palkki (Assoc Director of Choral Activities & Asst Professor, ASU). This will be outside.

4:15PM: Performers will begin lining up to enter the field. From there, all performers will be directed onto the field by D-backs representatives. If you are not in your designated area at this time, you will be unable to participate.

Approx. 4:57PM: The performance will begin on the warning-track in center field.

All groups must quickly exit the field after the performance and head back to your seats. Zones 1 and 2 will exit via Left Field. Zones 3 and 4 will exit via Right Field. Please keep walking up the stairs, and we cannot congregate on the main concourse.
